SPORTS PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

I (we) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, player, YMCA staff or other parents such as booing, taunting or using profane or inappropriate gestures.

I (we) will ensure that my child will be courteous to players, coaches and other parents.

I (we) will encourage playing fair and trying hard over winning at all costs.

I (we) will never ridicule another child for mistakes made during games.

I (we) will put heavy emphasis on skill development.

I (we) will respect YMCA staff and their decisions during games. I will never question or confront coaches or referees on the field. I may speak with coaches about concerns at an agreed upon place and time.
